OHCRA logo family





The OHCRA logo depicts paddlers in a Hawaiian Koa Canoe strengthening OHCRA's commitment to preserving the sport of Hawaiian Koa Canoe Racing in the State of Hawaii.

E Lau Hoe logo



The E Lau Hoe logo shall be used when referring specifically to the E Lau Hoe race. The colors of the logo mimic that in the Na Wahine O Ke Kai logo representing the women of OHCRA.

The Molokai Hoe and Na Wahine O Ke Kai logo family comes in both a dual color and single color vertical or horizontal image. The color logos will be primary with use of the single color logos when color is not available. Midnight blue is used in all logos to represent the Kaiwi channel. Ocean blue is used in the Molokai Hoe logo to represent the akua Kanaloa while pink is used to represent the akua Hina.

Clear space

Required 2x clear space. 1x= width of first the letter of the larger word within each logo family. (ie "O" in OHCRA, "M" in Molokai, "N" in Na.)

Separating graphic and wordmark

As long as minimum size requirements are followed, the graphic can be separated from the wordmark and scaled on its own. Remember to include the wordmark in the viewing area.
